

Job Description – Club Junior Coach – Grampian Orienteers

This is a voluntary role.

Responsible to: club committee

Usual Tasks will be some or all of the following:

- coaching at local junior coaching activities.
- occasional general supervision of children when travelling (shared cars, minibus, possibly public transport) and at events, usually with at least one adult colleague
- occasional duties at events such as ensuring competitors are at the Start on time, and/or being present at Finish
- occasional supervision of children in residential facility during weekends away, with at least one adult colleague

Duration/frequency:

- weekend trips up to 4 times each year, by prior arrangement
- individual days locally by agreement

This is “Regulated Work” under the terms of the Protection of Vulnerable Groups legislation and therefore requires the post-holder to be a PVG Scheme member.

You will be required to attend basic Child Protection training.

You are required to hold a British Orienteering coaching qualification or to undertake training for one within 6 months of being appointed.

You will be required to abide by the principles of British Orienteering’s Code of Conduct for Coaches.
