

Glen Dye Sunday 24/3/19 – Regional

Location

Glen Dye lies to the south of Strachan/Finzean and has a great mix of moraine contour and rock detail plus areas of much more subtle features to catch the unwary or blasé.


This event counts towards both GRAMP Champs and Jon Duncan Junior Deeside Cup.



Parking is on a forest track accessed from the minor road coming south from Finzean. Please follow parking marshal's directions.

A stretch of the B976 between Strachan and Finzean is scheduled to be closed for 28 days from 11/3/19 so competitors should access either from the road past Shooting Greens, turning right then left in Finzean village, or from Ballogie, turning right at Finzean, or from Strachan, turning right at the AA Box.

Courses

White, Yellow - short and easy on tracks and paths

Orange, Light Green - getting a bit longer and harder

Green, Blue, Brown - longest and most technical

Beginners very welcome - just come along on the day and chat to us at reg and we'll advise which course to try.

White	1.3km, 10m climb	***not suitable for buggies at GD***
Yellow	1.8km, 30m climb	***not suitable for buggies at GD***
Orange	2.4km, 100m climb	
Light Green	3.0km, 110m climb	
Green	3.7km, 145m climb	
Blue	5.8km, 210m climb	
Brown	7.6km, 310m climb.	

Light Green and above courses all use the lovely area of moraine between the Strachan and Finzean roads, which has not been used by any colour coded event since 2016.

Blue and Brown courses will find extensive areas of thinning, particularly south of the crossing point.
